

# Foundations in Learning, Teaching and Assessment

## Course description

The aim of this module is to provide practitioners in higher education and vocational education with an overview of learning, teaching and assessment practices for online learning.

### Participants will:

- Design and develop engaging learning activities that promote higher order thinking skills and active learning processes
- Design formative and summative assessments
- Reflect on their own teaching practice, and how to adapt this for the online learning environment
